# Setting and Fields of Action

- IPCC identified CLMV countries as highly vulnerable to impacts of climate change
- Low capacity to form adequate measures to adapt to impacts of climate change
- Germany has a leadership position in developing SDGs and in international climate politics
- Memorandum of Understanding with UNEP (scheduled to be renewed in June 2016)



**The project aims at promoting not only development but also implementation of mitigation and adaption measures to effects for climate change in the CLMV countries.**

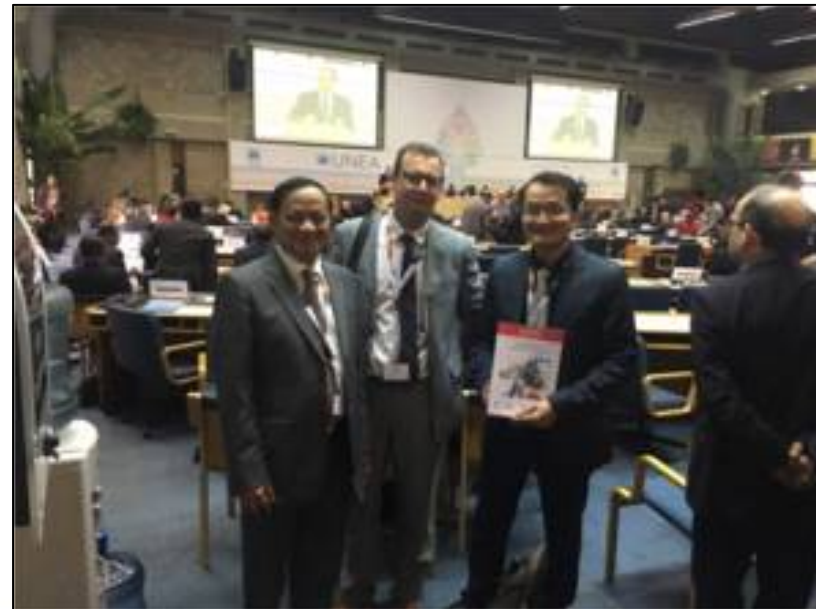
